New Academic Session : The school will reopen for the new academic session 2019–2020 as per the following schedule:

Std. X & XII	:	Academic Session begins on Tuesday, 05 th March, 2019.
Std. I to IX	:	Academic Session begins on Monday, 01 st April, 2019.
Std. XI	:	Academic Session begins on Wednesday, 10 th April, 2019.

It is mandatory for all the students to be present at 7:40 a.m. on the reopening day in summer uniform. Attendance is compulsory for all.

Admission to Std. XI: Admission to Std. XI will be based on the academic performance of periodic tests and the annual exam of Std. IX and periodic tests and pre-board exams of X. Please note that the criteria for admission to Std. XI are to get pass marks in all the subjects including Pre-Board. The list of students selected for different streams of Std. XI will be displayed on the school notice board on Friday, 05th April, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. New Academic Session for Std. XI will begin on Wednesday, 10th April, 2019.

The textbooks, notebooks, school belt & tie: For the convenience of the parents and students a tuck shop will be operational for a few days in the school campus from where the parents can collect the books and other stationery items required for their wards. The same arrangements have been made for the School Uniform also. A tailor will be available in the school from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. daily.


Scouts and Guide Three students of our school qualified for the President award which they will be receiving this year.
