GENERAL CIRCULAR NO. 1: 2020 – 21

Dear Parents / Guardians,

Cordial greetings from Xavier's C-Scheme,

COVID-19 pandemic has affected the humanity. Millions of people have tested positive and in thousands people have perished. Many nations have been in lockdown situation including India. In order to curtail the spread of this deadly virus the Govt. of India has extended the date of lockdown till May 03, 2020. Visuals on the plight of the victims who lost their jobs, people who stranded without any means to reach their homes, the poor and the migrant labourers are painful sights to behold. We hope and pray that may God mercifully shower his blessings on the plight of these suffering millions.

Initiatives undertaken by Xavierites:

Xavierites in their individual capacity, as part of the family and organizations have been rendering yeoman's service in the form of supplying food kits, medical kits, financial aid and medical assistance. *We appreciate and feel pride in all their endeavours.*

It is heartening to note that Xavier NCC and Scouts and Guide have been in the forefront in lending their support to the needy people. For the last couple of weeks, lunch was provided to 250+ people at Jaipur Railway Station. This noble task is likely to be continued till April 30, 2020. A digital initiative has been undertaken to inspire, inform and to create awareness about COVID-19, so that people may stay positive, calm and safe.

An appeal from The Xavier Alumni Society: As well known to you the warriors at the forefront fighting the deadly COVID-19 disease by risking their own safety are the medical fraternity (doctors, nurses, paramedics, health workers) and civil administration (police and other civil officials). Significant issues for immediate attention:

Online classes: I would like to thank all the parents for their enthusiastic support to our online classes and teaching material made available to all the students of classes I–XII through the Class / Subject teacher's WhatsApp group and the school's website. The study material has been shared for the grades X & XII from last week of March, from April 04, 2020 for classes I-IX and from the second week of April for XI std. Our teachers are working consistently and providing class appropriate content keeping the students engaged meaningfully in Academic and Co-curricular activities. It is heartening to note the support extended by the parents to their children and the teachers at this difficult time. We are grateful to you. The online classes will continue till further notification is issued by the Government of Rajasthan regarding summer holidays.

Syllabus and PT-1: The syllabus and the exam time-table for Periodic Test-1 will be framed keeping in mind the present scenario and the available number of working days without burdening the students. Any decision in this regard can only be taken when regular classes resume after the lockdown.

School fees: Keeping in mind the financial situation of the parents due to COVID- 19, the school management has decided **not to increase the school fees for the academic year 2020-21**. The fees will remain the same as that of last year for respective classes. The fee structure is given below for your reference. As a sign of solidarity with the suffering humanity, the management has decided to defer the payment of the first quarter fees (April, May and June) till the lockdown period is over. There is no compulsion to pay it right away. However, those parents who would like to pay the first quarter fees right away may use the online option as per the details available on the school website (Net banking / Debit card / Credit card, etc.). **Please note there is no debiting of the fees through ECS/ NACH for this quarter.** *Since the management has to pay the salary to the staff of the school during the lockdown period, we would urge all those who can pay the fees right now, please do so as it would lighten our financial burden.* The others will pay the first quarter fees once the lockdown period is over without any late fee charges.

Fee structure: The fee structure given below is **provisional** and applicable for the old students who have been promoted to the next class. **The final status of sections will be declared in July 2020.** The fee structure is common for all sections i.e. A, B, C, D, E or F. The students whose names are missing in the online fee data, due to technical errors, may contact the school office after the lockdown is lifted.


Please be assured that the Management is conscious and aware of the difficulties faced by each one of you and stands in solidarity with the entire Xavier family.
